



Invitation to the IOF Foot Orienteering and MTBO Event Advisers Clinic in Prague, Czech Republic, 26-27 February 2010

This Event Advisers' Clinic is organised for the education and recruitment of new IOF licensed Foot and Mountain Bike Orienteering Event Advisers. National orienteering federations are asked to identify and enter suitable candidates.

Course objectives and requirements:	The main objective of this IOF Event Advisers' Clinic is to prepare participants to be licensed IOF FootO Event Advisers and MTBO Event Advisers.

The requirements for licensing are:

1. Be an active foot or MTB orienteer.
2. Have competed in countries other than your own.
3. Have successfully controlled major national events in the last 3 years.
4. Be competent to communicate with IOF and the organising Federation (mainly in English).
5. Have attended, and have been an active participant in an IOF Event Advisers Clinic.
6. Be familiar with the IOF Rules and other relevant publications
7. Be recognised as a top standard controller/event adviser and endorsed as suitable by your Federation.

Course content:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Understanding of the task of an IOF Event Adviser (common to both FootO and MTBO)• Deeper understanding of the nature of orienteering and each format of FootO (long, middle, sprint, relay)• Understanding of the IOF rules and requirements for international competition (common to both FootO and MTBO) The course will include a short field exercise in course controlling.
