

***Invitation to the 7th IOF High Level Event Seminar
Tallinn, Estonia, 7-8 February 2015***

General theme: Visibility of orienteering

Focus areas: IOF services to organisers, WOC, WMOC and IT

The International Orienteering Federation, in cooperation with the Estonian Orienteering Federation (EOL), is pleased to invite you to the 2015 IOF High Level Event Seminar to be held at Pirita Top Spa Hotel in Tallinn, Estonia between 7-8 February, 2015.

This seminar, organised yearly since the start in 2009 in Oslo, Norway and last year held in Gothenburg, Sweden, has become an important event attracting 40-55 attendees each year from about 15 nations. The seminar targets appointed organisers, potential future organisers and key persons of IOF High Level Events, including already appointed IOF Senior Event Advisers and Assistant Senior Event Advisers. National orienteering federations are kindly asked to identify and enter suitable candidates.

Besides the ever important experience sharing, the 2015 seminar will have a special focus on the **follow-up of the introduction of the new WOC-model, IOF support to appointed high-level event organisers** and how to **improve the visibility of orienteering**.

Program points include:

- Elements of a WOC, management, organisation, support
- IOF support to organisers (Eventor, LiveCenter and the role of the Office)
- Focus on elite orienteering: evaluation of the 2014 FootO season, expectation from coaches and athletes, sprint relay (evaluation and experiences from 2014)
- IT – a cornerstone of a modern high level event in orienteering
- Organising the World Masters Orienteering Championships (WMOC) – including first-hand information from the WMOC 2014 SEA
- Visibility of orienteering – how the new WOC-programme changed WOC; and the example from the experienced Swiss World Cup organising team
- WOC project updates
