Course Objectives and Requirements:	<p>The chief objective of this IOF Orienteering Event Advisers' Clinic is to train participants to be licensed IOF Orienteering Event Advisers.</p> <p>After attending the clinic, the requirements for licensing are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be an active and experienced orienteer. 2. Have competed in orienteering in countries other than your own. 3. Have successfully controlled or played a major part in the organisation of national or international standard orienteering events in the last 3 years. 4. Be competent to communicate with IOF and the organising Federation in English. 5. Have attended, and have been an active participant in an IOF Orienteering Event Advisers Clinic. 6. Be familiar with the IOF Orienteering Competition Rules and other relevant publications. 7. Be recognised as a top standard controller/event adviser and endorsed as suitable by your Federation.
