A SPORTS EVENT LATIN-AMERICA HAD NEVER SEEN BEFORE

The World Games are an international sports event that is carried out every 4 years and where thousands of athletes (the best of each sport) from over 200 countries meet to strive for excellence.

Its 1st edition took place in 1981, in Santa Clara –California followed by London/UK, The Hague/Netherlands, Karlsruhe/Germany, Lahti/Finland, Akita/Japan, Duisburg/Germany and Kaohsiung/Chinese Taipei.

The 9th edition of this important world event will arrive for the first time in Latin America in 2013 (TWG2013) under the motto

The competition program of The World Games 2013 will stage more than 170 medal events in 31 sports: 26 official and 5 invitational which include: Salsa as dance sport, Gymnastics, Roller Sports, Finswimming, Wushu, Waterski, Ju-Jitsu, Air sports, Archery, Beach Handball, Billiard, Bowling, Flying Disc, Karate, Orienteering, Power Lifting, Racquetball, Roller Sports, Sport Climbing, Squash, Sumo, Duathlon, Softball, Canoe Marathon
