RE: Council nominations to the 2018 IOF General Assembly

This letter is being sent to clarify the nominations and election process for the IOF Council in connection with the 2018 General Assembly to be held in Prague, Czech Republic on October 6th, 2018.

At the General Assembly in Italy in 2014, the IOF Statutes were changed and the term length for Council members was increased from 2 to 4 years. A rotation system was introduced at the same time which means that 5 Council members terms are ending in connection with the 2018 General Assembly, and elections will be held for these Council positions. The following Council members terms are ending as of the General Assembly 2018:

Vice President	Mike Dowling (AUS)
Vice President	Mikko Salonen (FIN)
Member	Dominic Yue (HKG)
Member	Maria Silvia Viti (ITA)
Member	Tatiana Kalenderoglu (TUR)

Member federations currently having one of the above Council members on the IOF Council are reminded that their written intention to re-nominate the current member or not, shall be received by the IOF Secretary General at the latest 6 months prior to the General Assembly. This means by April 5th, 2018. This information, and a call for nominations, will be sent out to all member federations shortly thereafter.

All Member Federations are reminded that nominations to the IOF Council are to be received in writing by the IOF Secretary General at the latest 4 months prior to the General Assembly. In other words, by June 5th, 2016.
